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OUTCOMES

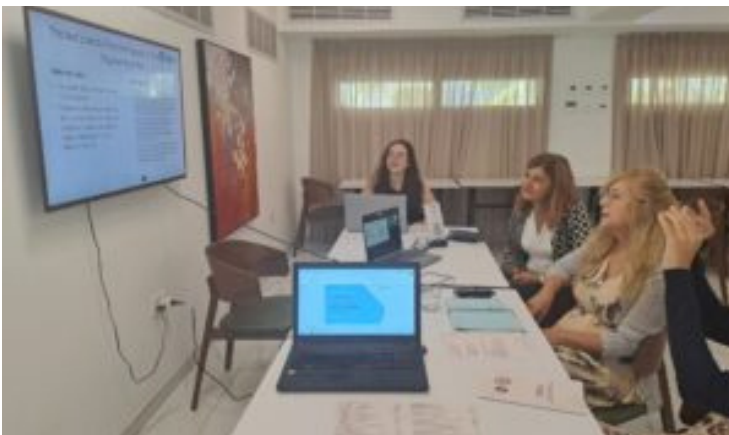

and intersectoral approaches

Course overview

This innovative course gathers the knowledge and tools developed and shared throughout the NEXUS project's Work Package 4, "Capacity-building, mutual learning and knowledge sharing". The course is designed for anyone passionate about advancing gender equality within research organizations. With a focus on intersectional and intersectoral approaches, the course shares the knowledge and tools needed to create inclusive Gender Equality Plans and foster a more equitable environment in your institution.



What you'll learn

1. How to integrate **intersectional and intersectoral approaches** into research and structural change processes.
2. How to incorporate a **sex and gender dimension** with an intersectional approach into research and teaching.
3. How to address **gender-based violence in academia**.

Who should enroll?

This course is ideal for: Administration (e.g., HR) and management staff of research-performing organizations; Academic staff (lecturers/instructors) in higher education institutions across all fields; Researchers across all disciplines in research-performing organizations; Doctoral candidates and students in higher education institutions.

Course format

The course is self-directed, allowing you to start now and progress at your own rhythm. The course is structured in three modules, each containing 3 to 5 lessons. Each module includes optional assignments aimed at self-assessing your knowledge and trying to apply learnings to your own context. Course materials and references lists are also provided. Upon completing the course and the final quiz, you will obtain a certificate of attendance. Participation is upon registration and free of charge.
